NANDUR MADHMESHWAR



Nandur Madhmeshwar Bird sanctuary is in Niphad Tehsil of Nashik district in western Maharashtra. It is an important wetland with 23 lakes and tiny ponds. The sanctuary is known for the avian population and is also referred to as "Maharashtra's Bharapur".

The International Ramsar convention on wetlands has declared the Nandur Madhameshwar wetlands as Ramsar wetlands. It is the first wetlands in the Maharashtra state and among the nine wetlands in India declared by the convention as Ramsar sites. The Birds sanctuary is developed around Nandur Madhmeshwar Dam which is constructed on the confluence of the Godavari and Kadwa rivers.

Districts / Region.

Tehsil : Niphad , District : Nashik , state : Maharashtra.

History :-

Nandur Madhmeshwar Bird Sanctuary is a harbor for thousands of beautiful and migratory birds in Maharashtra. There are more than 235 species of birds, out of which 80 are migratory species. The migratory birds found in this sanctuary are white stork, Glossy Ibis, spoonbills, flamingo, Goose Brahminy duck, pintails, Mallard, wigeon, Garganey shoveller, prachards, cranes shanks, curlews, pratincole wagtails, Godwits, weavers, etc.

The inhabitant birds consists of Black Ibis, Spot Bills, Teals, little Grebe, cormorants, egrets, Herons, stork, kites, vultures, Buzzards, Harriers, osprey, etc.

There are around 460 species of plant, out of which almost 80 are aquatic plants species. The trees that are found on the edges of the lakes are Babul, neem, tamarind, Jamun, maharukh, vilayati chinch, mango, pangara, nigiri etc.

Sericulture



Sericulture, or silk farming, is the cultivation of silkworms to produce silk. Although there are several commercial species of silkworms, *Bombyx mori* (the caterpillar of the domestic silkworm) is the most widely used and intensively studied silkworm. Silk was believed to have first been produced in China as early as the Neolithic period.

The silkworms are fed with mulberry leaves, and after the fourth moult, they climb a twig placed near them and spin their silken cocoons. The silk is a continuous filament comprising fibroin protein, secreted from two salivary glands in the head of each worm, and a gum called sericin is removed by placing the cocoons in hot water, which frees the silk filaments and readies them for reeling.

This is known as the degumming process. The immersion in hot water also kills the silkworm pupa.

Beekeeping Apiculture

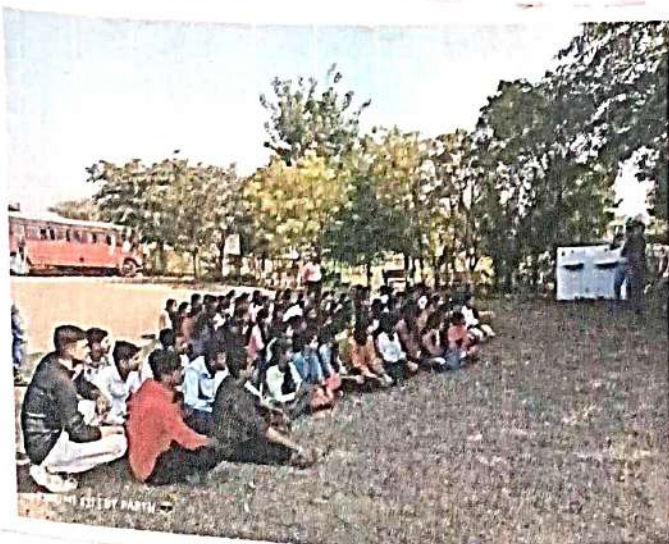
